1. Public Comment: Kris Baderschler asked when crosswalks are painted (A: DPW is moving earlier to spring time when possible)
2. Approve May 24, 2018 minutes by unanimous vote, upon motion by Michael DiPaquale and second by Eric Boudreau.
3. ValleyBike stations, opening and parade- The system launches on June 28, 2018 with a celebration and parade.
4. Main Street redesign request for proposals—The committee spend most of the meeting reviewing the draft RFP and providing detailed suggestions.
5. City Hall accessibility improvements and Cracker Barrel Alley—The city hall portion of the project will be done in early July. The project will be expanded across Main Street to close the alley to vehicle traffic with a new curb, new sidewalks, a wider tree opening, and moving the north side of the crosswalk west ten feet, all as recommended in a series of traffic studies. The alley will not be converted to a formal park given strong abutter concerns.
6. Form based code- Field work is underway, business focus groups planned for the summer, and community meetings in the fall. Bike/Ped will be a sounding board for the process.
7. Movable parklet- Installed for 2018 on Market Street
8. DPW updates- repaving project out to bid.
9. Set next meeting date—Wed. August 1, 2018.
