

The polls will be opened at seven o'clock in the forenoon and closed at eight o'clock in the evening of the said day, and all such voters will within the the said hours in the wards in which they are individually entitled to vote give in their votes for Mayor for the two ensuing municipal years, for City Clerk for the two ensuing municipal years, for two Councillors at Large for the two ensuing municipal years, for one Councillor from each of the seven wards of the City for the two ensuing municipal years, for two members of the School Committee at Large for two years from the first Monday of January, 2010, for Four members of the School Committee to serve for four years from the first Monday of January, 2010, one to be taken from the inhabitants of Ward One, one from the inhabitants of Ward Three, one from the inhabitants of Ward Five and one from the inhabitants of Ward Seven, for three Superintendents of Smith's Agricultural School to serve for two years from the first Monday of January, 2010, for one Elector under the Oliver Smith Will for two years from the first Wednesday of May, 2010, for two Trustees under the Will of Charles E. Forbes for four years from the first Monday of January, 2010.
