WHEREAS: Foster families, who open their homes and hearts and offer help to children whose families are in crisis, play a vital role in helping children and families heal, reconnect and launch children into successful adulthood; and

WHEREAS: Dedicated foster families frequently adopt foster children, resulting in a greater need for more foster families; and

WHEREAS: There are numerous individuals and public and private organizations who work to increase public awareness of the needs of children leaving foster care as well as the enduring and valuable contribution of foster parents;
