


Proclamation



CITY OF NORTHAMPTON COMMONWEALTH OF MASSACHUSETTS

100th Anniversary of the Governorship of Calvin Coolidge

- Whereas,** Calvin Coolidge served as City Solicitor, City Councilor and Mayor of the City of Northampton; State Representative, State Senator, Lieutenant Governor and Governor of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts; and Vice-President and President of the United States; and,
- Whereas,** Calvin Coolidge was a resident of Northampton from 1895 to 1933; and,
- Whereas,** Calvin Coolidge worked with Joseph Harrison, librarian at Forbes Library to share his papers and memorabilia of public service with the citizens of Northampton in what is now known as the Calvin Coolidge Presidential Library and Museum; and,
- Whereas,** Calvin Coolidge served 2 terms as Mayor of the City of Northampton from January 1910 to December 1911. His Mayoral service marked an upward climb to office and continuous public service until his Presidential retirement in March of 1929; and,
- Whereas,** Calvin Coolidge was elected as the 48th Governor of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts on November 5th, 1918 to serve beginning January 2nd, 1919 and re-elected on November 4th, 1919 to serve until January 6th, 1921; and so,
- Now,**
- Therefore I,** Mayor David J. Narkewicz declare that November 5th, 2018 will be a day to celebrate the 100th anniversary of the election of Northampton resident, Calvin Coolidge, as Governor of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts.
