

# WHAT TO BRING TO A HOUSEHOLD HAZ WASTE COLLECTION

*Household products with warnings on the label such as Warning, Danger, Caution, Poison, Irritant, Caustic, Toxic, Corrosive, Irritant, Flammable, and “Keep out of reach of children”*

A/C refrigerants (Freon)	Flea powders	Paint: oil, marine, lead & hobby
Antifreeze	Fluorescent bulbs-all types	Paint thinners/solvents/strippers
Arts & crafts supplies	Furniture polish	Pesticides/insect sprays/pest-strips
Auto & truck batteries	Gasoline	Photographic supplies
Automotive fluids (including oil)	Herbicides	Pool chemicals
Button batteries	Insect pump sprays	Rechargeable batteries
Kerosene	Rodent killers	Creosote
Lead acid batteries	Root killers	Chemistry kits
Lead paints	Septic tank cleaners	DDT
Metal polishes	Spot removers/solvents	Disinfectants
Mothballs	Swimming pool chemicals	Drain cleaners
Motor oil (contaminated only)	Thermostats & thermometers	Dry gas
Muriatic acid	Toilet cleaners	Engine degreasers

## PLEASE **DO NOT** BRING

Latex & water-based products such as paints, stains, & driveway sealers (labels will say “latex,” “water-based” or “Clean up with soap and water.”)

Aerosol cans that contain anything *other than* paint, pesticide or disinfectant

Empty containers from hazardous products\*

Explosives & fireworks

Fertilizer without pesticides\*

Glass & window cleaners\*

Asbestos

Car waxes/polishes/cleaners\*

Caulk/spackle/grout\*

Cosmetics\*

Empty containers from hazardous products\*

Air fresheners/deodorizers\*

Alkaline or carbon-zinc batteries\*

Ammunition

Medical/infectious waste

PCB's (transformers)

Propane tanks/cylinders

Smoke detectors

Scouring powders\*

\*These Items may be safely disposed in your household trash or given away for use. Free-flowing liquids must be dried out prior to disposal.
