Thank you for purchasing a 2024/2025 Transfer Station Vehicle Permit.

This permit is valid June 17, 2024 through June 30, 2025.

The sticker must be affixed on the inside, lower left corner of the driver side windshield.

If you currently have a Transfer Station Permit fixed to your window, please remove it and replace it with the current one.



If you sell your vehicle or replace the windshield, please scrape off your sticker in order to get a replacement sticker at no charge. Replacement cost without the original sticker is \$75.00

Recycling & Transfer Station Rules & Regulations

- ❖ **Permit MUST be affixed to the windshield, in proper spot, for entry.**
- ❖ **Speed limit is 5 MPH.** Vehicle and pedestrian safety is a top priority. Please follow the directions of Public Works employee(s) at all times. **NO WALK-INS.**
- ❖ Vehicle and pedestrian traffic will be halted when containers are being loaded or unloaded. No pedestrian passing is allowed behind, beside or in front of containers being loaded or unloaded.
- ❖ City vehicles and equipment have the right of way at all times.
- ❖ Parking is limited to designated areas only. No parking by containers is allowed at any time.
- ❖ Designated spaces are marked for use by vehicles displaying a proper license plate or placard. Unauthorized use of designated spaces is prohibited by ordinance.
- ❖ All residents using the facility should be able to do so on their own. If not, residents should bring someone who can assist them as attendants may not be available.
- ❖ Carts are available for transporting items from vehicles to containers. Carts must be returned to the cart area after use. Do not leave carts in the parking area.
- ❖ Trash disposal of any kind outside of posted operating hours is not permitted. Non-acceptable materials left behind and after hours dumping is illegal.
- ❖ Foul language, gestures or honking of horns will not be tolerated.
- ❖ Smoking is prohibited.
- ❖ Scavenging or salvaging is prohibited.
- ❖ No Idling – please turn off your engine.
- ❖ Vehicle doors must be closed at all times.
- ❖ Pets must remain in vehicles
- ❖ The City of Northampton is not responsible for missing or lost items.
- ❖ All bags must be tied before disposal. All bag weight limits must be observed.
- ❖ Anything that cannot be recycled must be taken back with you and put in your blue bag. We can no longer dispose of it for you.

Rules and regulations are intended to facilitate the orderly use and management of the city's solid waste facilities. The Director of Public Works and/or designee shall be responsible, as agents for the Board of Health, for enforcing these rules and regulations. Failure to comply with these Rules and Regulations as stated above or in accordance with the Northampton Ordinance Code § 272-1 thru § 272-22 shall result in a written or verbal warning. Subsequent offenses may result in revocation of the Transfer Station Permit(s) and/or subject to court action at the violator's expense.
