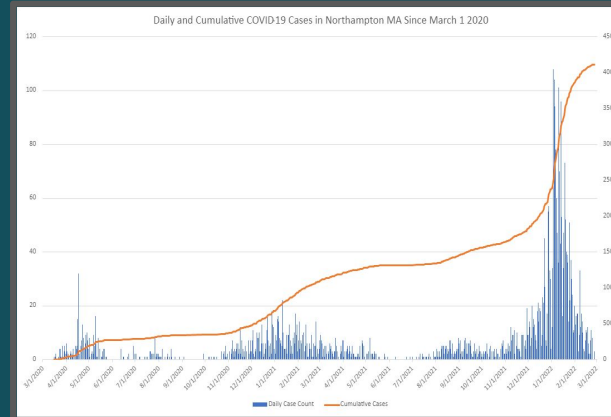
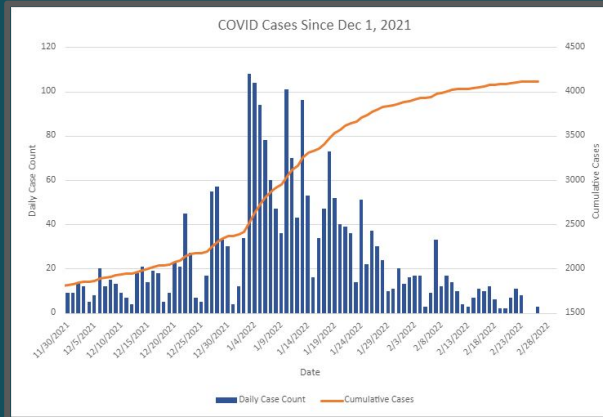

**Active cases are cases with reported positive molecular and antigen results, who are currently in isolation under public health supervision.

****Hospitalization and mortality data is calculated based on clinical data for confirmed, laboratory molecular tested cases of COVID-19 only. It does not include data extracted from cases with antigen tests, or otherwise probable or suspect cases of COVID-19. Clinical data is drawn from MAVEN surveillance reporting, individual patient report, and vitals statistics. Data may therefore be incomplete. Mortality and hospitalization data includes residents of long term care and assisted living facilities who may have had previous or permanent residence in another town/city.
