

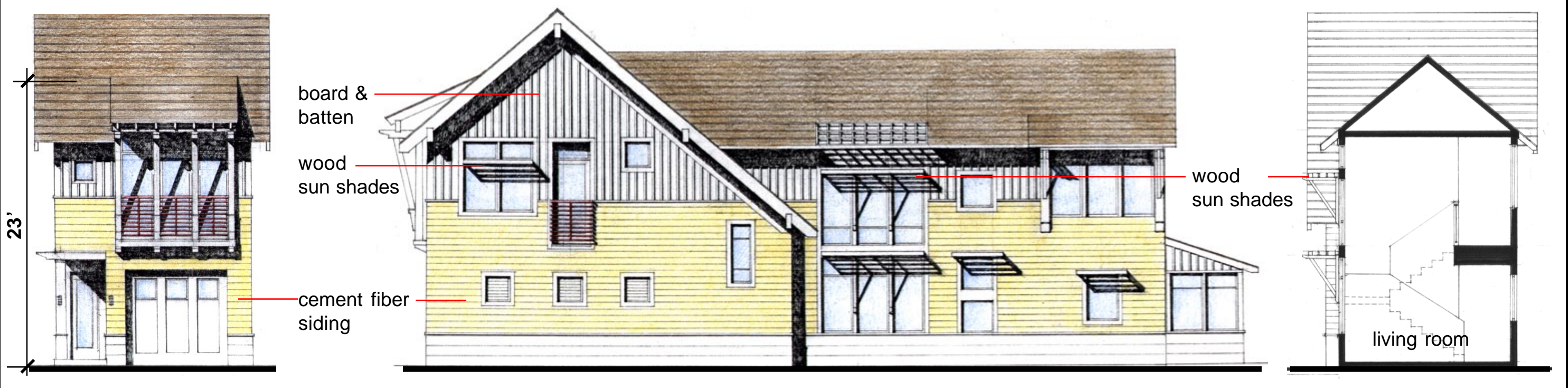


**SIDEWALK VIEW

**Narrow Lot Single-Family
House Design**

Narrative: The proposal seeks a building type that is appropriate in scale and character to older existing homes. Elements from wooden vernacular structures of the Pacific Northwest inspired the building form that mitigates the vertical proportions with a gable side and shed roof facing the street. The building frontage is activated with an entry porch and balcony with projecting brackets. The garage becomes a secondary feature and addresses the pedestrian with windows to the street.

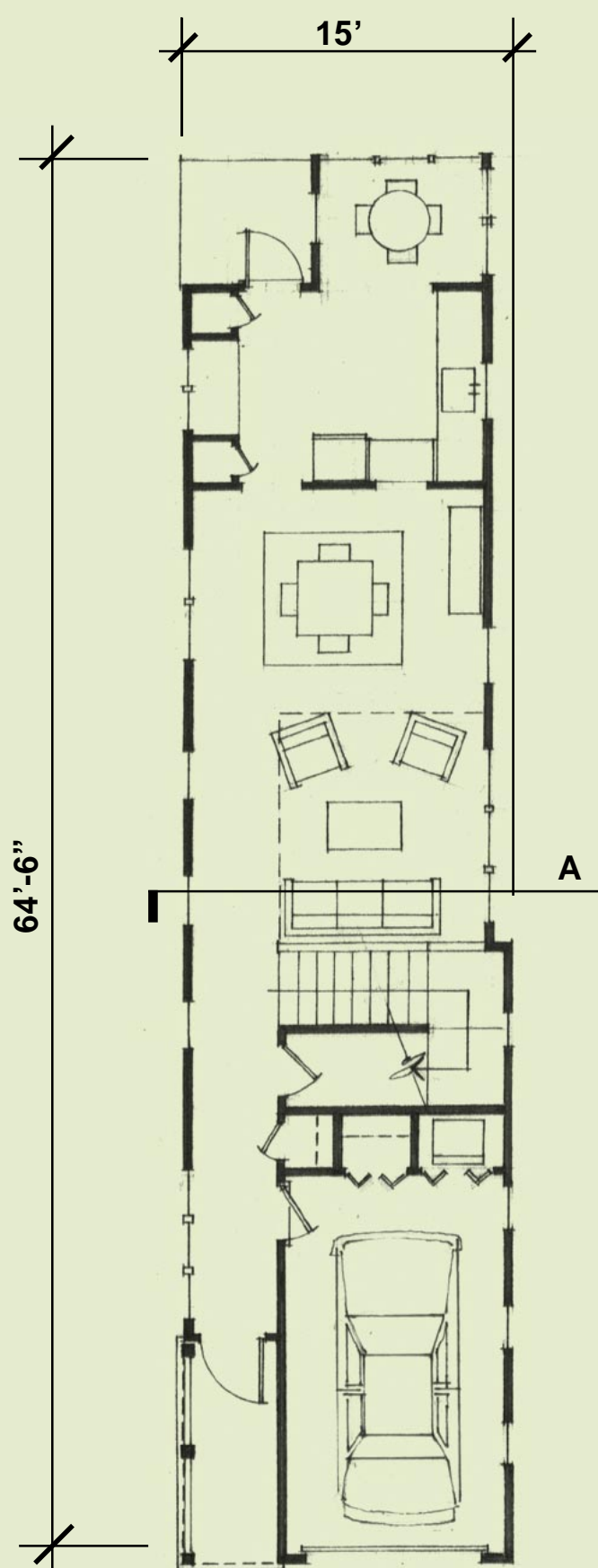

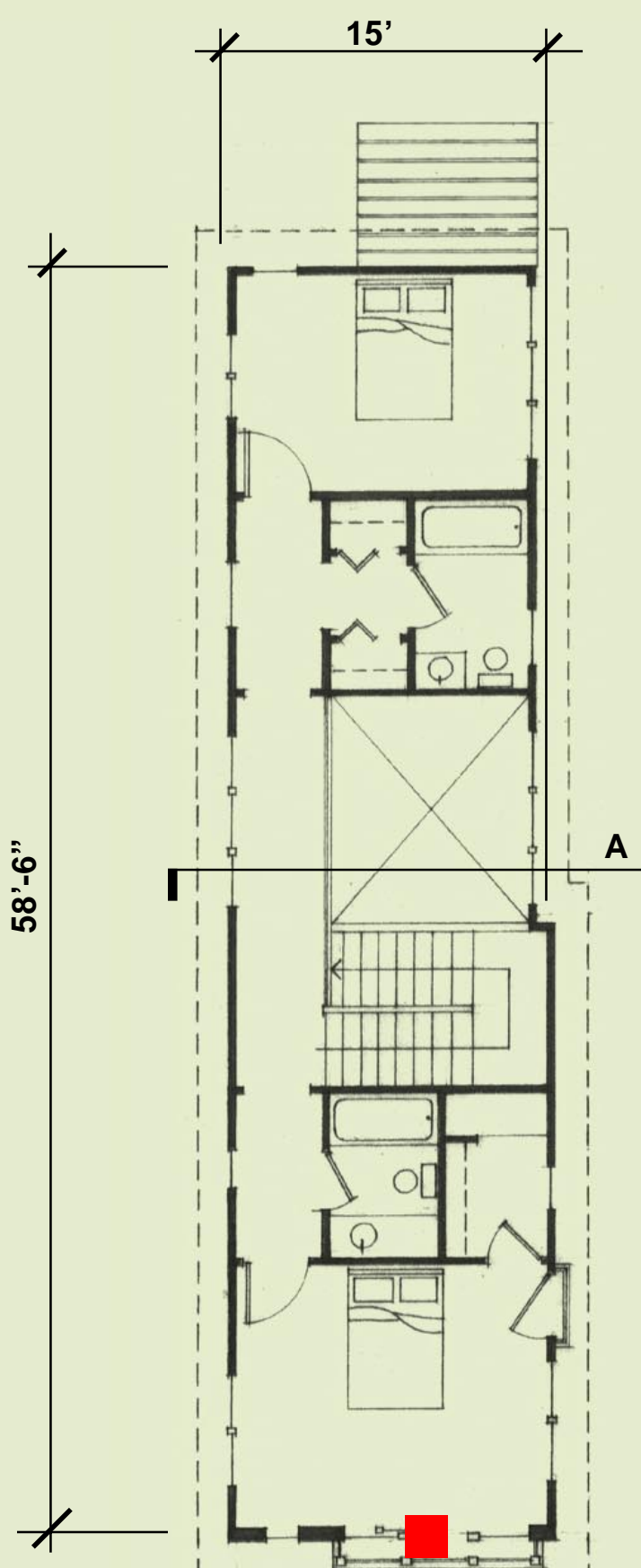
WEST ELEVATION
